SPIRITUAL GROWTH ASSESSMENT

All of us are on a spiritual journey, and when viewed through the lens of the four stages of spiritual maturity, the potential for spiritual growth is amplified. The four stages, CHAIR 1 (REACH), CHAIR 2 (BUILD), CHAIR 3 (EQUIP) and CHAIR 4 (MULTIPLY), can bring clarity to our understanding of the spiritual growth process and can help define next steps in our pursuit of following Jesus. It is our hope that as we view our spiritual journey in light of the four stages, our desire to mature spiritually will increase. With this hope in mind, we have designed the Spiritual Growth Assessment. Prayerfully use this tool to evaluate yourself because we believe it will help shape you into the person God wants you to become.

WHAT IS THE SPIRITUAL GROWTH ASSESSMENT?

"Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you fail to meet the test!" 2 Corinthians 13:5

The Bible instructs us to evaluate our spiritual lives so we have developed the Spiritual Growth assessment to help you evaluate your spiritual growth in six key areas or disciplines:

- LIFESTYLE Is my lifestyle demonstrating that I'm a follower of Jesus? (Titus 2:11-12)
- GOD'S WORD Am I spending time in the Bible and does it reflect in my attitudes and actions? (2 Timothy 3:16-17; James 1:22)
- PRAYER Is my prayer life demonstrating a deepening trust and dependence upon God? (Philippians 4:6-7)
- RELATIONSHIPS Are my relationships with others loving and healthy? (John 13:34-35)
- EVANGELISM Am I sharing my faith to others? (1 Peter 2:12)
- SERVING Am I using my God given resources and abilities for His purposes? (Galatians 6:10)

This assessment will measure how you are progressing toward spiritual maturity. When the assessment is completed, you will have a snapshot showing you the stage to which you are most closely aligned.

HOW DO I TAKE THE SPIRITUAL GROWTH ASSESSMENT?

The assessment consists of ten statements for each of the six disciplines, totaling sixty statements. It should take about fifteen minutes to complete the assessment. Score each statement honestly, as it applies to you. This is not designed to compare you with others; the goal is to provide you with a snapshot of where you are today in your spiritual journey and reveal potential growth areas.

- 1. Begin with the first discipline, LIFESTYLE. Read each statement, and assign a score (1-5) for each.
- 2. Continue to the next disciplines, assigning scores for each statement like in the first step.
- 3. Once you have completed all six disciplines, total the scores for each.
- 4. Find the Spiritual Growth Wheel and write your scores under the corresponding disciplines.
- 5. Once you have determined a number value for all six disciplines, total all your scores and divide by six.

Your overall score will provide you with the stage of maturity with which you are most closely aligned in your spiritual journey today. This will help you discover areas for potential growth.
