ACTIVITY | JESUS IS ANOINTED AT BETHANY

ANOINTING WASH

In this activity, your child will use sensory play to develop an understanding of anointing, just like they saw in their Bible story about the woman who anointed Jesus at Bethany.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Fill two bowls half way up with water.
2. Add soap to one of the bowls.
3. On a towel or in a place that is safe to get wet, set out both bins along with a wash cloth and cup.

DO

1. Pick out a special toy to wash and get ready for Easter.
2. Before placing the toy in the soapy water have your child pour a cup full of water over the toy's head.
3. Explain the Bible connection as they do this.
4. Let your child free play with washing and cleaning their toys so they are ready for Easter.

BIBLE CONNECTION

Jesus was anointed at Bethany.

This reminds us of what the woman did for Jesus in our Bible story at church. She *anointed* Jesus with a special perfume. That means she poured a special oil on Jesus' head to honor him. It was a very special thing she did to show Jesus she loved him.
