Directions:

1. Take sometime to get together with the people in your life. Begin with people in your household, then maybe reach out to other people in your life via FaceTime, Hangouts, Zoom, Marco Polo, etc. with friends and family outside your home.
2. Tell them you just heard about a story in the Bible about one of Jesus' disciples, Thomas, who had doubts that Jesus was really alive after He had died. But Thomas knew about his friend and knew what question to ask that would help him know for certain it was his friend Jesus who had just come back to life!
3. Use this activity as a fun way to see how well you know the people closest to you. As you listen to one another, you just might learn something new about them.
4. Have fun and be honest!

TALKING POINTS

Here are some questions to ask to get you started.

- Who is your hero/biggest influence now or when you were the age of the child?
- Do you believe in Jesus?
 - If yes, when did you start believing and what are you learning about Jesus now?
 - If no, what questions do you have about Jesus?
- What are some things that cause you to doubt like Thomas? How do you overcome your doubts?
- If Jesus was right in front of you, what is one thing you'd ask or tell him?
- If you could only eat one meal for the rest of your life, what would you choose?
- What is your favorite part about your job or school?
- What makes you laugh the most? What makes you angry? What makes you happy?
- What did you want to be when you were the age of the child? When you grew up?
- What are you most proud of?
- What is one thing you are thankful for today?
