

PETER'S LACE UP PRISON BARS

This week, your child learned about when Peter escaped prison with help from God. This Bible story shows us that we can do the things God has asked us to do because of the power of the Holy Spirit. With this craft, your child will be reminded of how God helped Peter and that God will help them do the things He asks them to do, too!



PREP

- 1. Print out a copy of the Peter's prison bars printable.
 - Option: Create your own scene. Use the printable as a guide.
- 2. Have scissors, the printable, string, and crayons ready for your child.

DO

- 1. Have your child color and decorate Peter's prison scene.
- 2. Help your child punch holes in the 8 circles above and below Peter and the angel using scissors, a hole punch, or another object.
- 3. Help your child lace the yarn through the holes to make prison bars.
- 4. Say something like, Oh no! Peter is in prison. He needs help getting out! Do you remember who God sent to free Peter?
- 5. Your child can pretend to be the angel that frees Peter by removing the yarn. When Peter was freed, he could do what God asked him to do and tell everyone about Jesus.
