



## WIND POWER GAME

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Supplies: Cotton balls, straws, painters tape or masking tape

Directions:

1. Use tape to make a start line and a finish line on the floor or a long table.
2. Give each player their own straw and their own cotton ball.
3. Each person will place their cotton ball on the starting line.
4. 3-2-1-GO! And each person will use wind power to blow air through their straw to move the cotton ball to the finish line.
5. First cotton ball to reach the finish line, wins!

Alternative ways to play: You may choose to use the tape to create an obstacle course, build tunnels to blow the cotton balls through, etc.

## TALKING POINTS

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Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- That was fun using wind power to play that game! It makes me think about what was talked about in the Bible story and Power Up videos. The same wind power that we used to play this game is the same power that is used when we talk. And even more powerful than our own voice is our voice with the power of the Holy Spirit. Remember: Because of the power of the Holy Spirit, I can share the Good News of Jesus with others.
- The Bible says in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere." What does this verse tell you that you do when you receive the power of the Holy Spirit?
- Have you ever shared about Jesus with someone? How did it go? What was difficult/easy for you? How did other people respond?
- Who in your life needs to hear the Good News about Jesus? How can the Holy Spirit help you share? What way would you like the Holy Spirit to help you share? Ask for that help.
- How would you describe God's power? Why do we need the Holy Spirit?
- Take some time to write down some prayers to God. Write down the names of the people you are praying to know Jesus and that you could share the Good News with them.
