## **FAMILY GAME NIGHT: LEGO CONTEST**

Supplies: Legos

## Directions:

- 1. If you have enough, divide out the Legos evenly between family members. Otherwise, each person will take turns building.
- 2. Agree on one item for everyone to build, like the space ship we saw in the video, a house, a dog, a person, etc.
- 3. Everyone will have a chance to build the same thing, either all at the same time or one person at a time.
- 4. Take turns complimenting each other's creations and take a family vote on your favorite!

## **TALKING POINTS**

Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- That was fun getting to be creative and try to build something out of just Legos!
- It was kind of hard though, right? We didn't have any plans to guide us, we were just trying to figure it out on our own and somehow make something that looked good.
- Jehoshaphat begged God to guide him and help him understand God's plans. He knew he could ask God for help and God's plans would be best.
- When we experience things that are hard or feel like we're trying to figure things out on our own, we can ask God to help us.
- How can we ask God to help us understand his plans?
- Have you ever felt like you didn't understand why something was happening?
- What about Jehoshaphat's story makes you feel comforted?
- What is a time you can set aside each day to pray to God?
- What if things still don't make sense? What if you still have questions? What can you do?
- God loves you and has good plans for you. But sometimes we have to wait for his answer and God's perfect timing. Who can you ask to pray with you?
