Directions:

1. Get the memory verse song ready to go.
2. Practice the Helmet Man's memory verse song dance moves you saw in Church at Home or choreograph your own!
3. Bring the whole family together to learn and dance to the Jeremiah 29:11 song as a way to memorize the Bible verse together.

## TALKING POINTS

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Get together and talk about how this activity helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- Wow, dancing together is so fun! It always makes me feel better just to laugh and be silly. And even more fun, now we all know this Bible verse a little better!
- When things aren't going the way we want them to, it always makes me feel better to spend time with people I love, laugh and do something fun, and read God's Word.
- Hannah from our Bible story was really upset, sad, and even frustrated that she didn't have a baby of her own. And she told God exactly how she felt.
- How can you talk to God? What kinds of things do you talk to him about?
- Do you think it's okay to tell God when you are angry or disappointed?
- Why do you think you can talk to God about how you really feel? Is it okay to be completely honest with God? What does it look like to be completely honest with him?
- Sometimes, it can be hard to know what to say. When we don't know what to say, we can say Bible verses to God. Just think of the memory verse song with Helmet Guy! You can sing God's promise for good plans for your life! Let's remember the song and Bible verse we learned today to sing it the next time we get upset or hurt.
