



GOD'S GOOD PLANS

ACTIVITY | LESSON 1

PRAYER PUTTY

In this activity, your child will make their own Prayer Putty so that they can play as they talk with God. As they do this activity, they will be encouraged to do what Jehoshaphat and all the people of Judah did – pray to God.

DIRECTIONS

1. Mix 2 tablespoons of dish soap and 1.5 tablespoons of corn starch together as best as you can for about 10 seconds.
2. Once it becomes difficult to stir, get your hands in there!
3. Work the putty until all of the ingredients in the bowl are combined thoroughly. This is when you'll see the putty start to come together.
 - TIP: If the putty is too dry, add a little more dish soap. If the putty is too runny, add a little more corn starch.
4. Let your child know that God wants to be a part of everything they do. He even likes to be with them when they pray and play.
5. Allow your child to play with their Prayer Putty and pray together. Ask God to be with you, help you, and show you his good plans. Tell him about your day and about the putty you just made.

Dish soap
