ELEPHANT LISTENING EARS

Use this craft to remind your child that they can always do what God says. To help reinforce this teaching objective, your child will create their own listening ears headband in the shape of elephant ears. Elephant ears are big and remind us that it is important to listen to God. They also remind us of the Bible story about Noah when the animals came on the ark. Noah shows us that we can trust God and do what he says.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print Elephant Listening Ears printable.
 - Option: Create your own elephant ears headband using the printable as a guide.

DO

1. Help your child cut out their Elephant Listening Ears headband.
2. Have them color it.
3. While your child colors, read what is written on the headband. It says, "I can always do what God says."
4. Take the paper strip and attach it to one end of the elephant ears and size it to your child's head.
5. Go through any remaining talking points.
