CRAFT | LESSON 5

BRAVERY SHIELD

Use this craft to remind your child that they can be brave because God's plan is the best. To help reinforce this teaching objective, your child will create their own bravery shield to remind them that God is bigger and stronger than the scary or confusing things in life. He hears their prayers and has good plans for them, just like he did with Daniel.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print the Bravery Emblem printable.
 - Option: Create your own emblem using the printable as a guide.
2. Cut out a shield shape using cardboard or thick paper that is a couple inches larger than the emblem.

DO

1. Give your child the Bravery Emblem printable to color for their shield.
2. Have your child decorate and create their own special shield.
 - Fun decorating option: Place shield in a bin or covered area. Help your child step onto a chair or stool above the shield and drop paint-soaked cotton balls on to the shield making splat art.
3. Tape or glue the Bravery Emblem to the shield.
4. Talk through the talking points together.
5. Once their shield is finished, they can have fun playing with it and be reminded that God will help them be brave because he is bigger and stronger than everything.
