CRAFT | LESSON 1

WHERE'S THE SHEEP?

Use this craft to remind your child of God's promise to take care of them. To help reinforce this teaching objective, your child will create their own sheep that they will look for in the same way the shepherd goes after the one lost sheep.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print the Lost Sheep printable.
 - Note: Multiple sheep are provided on the printable for your family. Just one per child is needed for the craft.
 - Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

DO

1. Help your child cut out the printable.
2. Decorate your sheep by coloring and sticking on pieces of cotton balls. Dip cotton balls into glue to stick onto the sheep, making the sheep's wool.
3. Get three cups and turn them upside down.
4. Hide the sheep under one of the cups.
5. Move the cups around so that the sheep gets "lost."
6. Have your child guess where the sheep went and "find" the sheep under the cup.
