## SUPER SKUPPET STRAW LAUNCHER

Use this craft to remind your child of God's promise to give them a purpose. To help reinforce this, your child will create their own Crimson Wonder from the Super Skuppets comic. As they launch the Crimson Wonder into the sky, they will remember his ability to fly. God gives us unique abilities and talents to use for the purpose God gives us.



### DIRECTIONS

#### PREP

1. Print the Crimson Wonder printable.
  - Note: Multiple pictures are provided on the printable for your family. Just one Crimson Wonder per child is needed for the craft.
  - Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

#### DO

1. Help your child cut out the Crimson Wonder printable and keep the excess paper.
2. Have your child color the Crimson Wonder.
3. Use the excess paper to cut out a strip of paper (approximately 2 inches by 1½ inch).
4. Tape the strip of paper to the back of the Crimson Wonder, leaving a pocket open on the bottom to insert the straw.
5. Help your child insert the straw into the open pocket.
6. With the Crimson Wonder pointing up to the sky, have your child blow on the open end of the straw to launch their Crimson Wonder.
