



HELPING HANDS WREATH

Use this craft as a reminder that, because we are made in God's image, we can help people. Your child will remember that just like the Good Samaritan helped the injured man, they can help other people, too. They can have helpful hands.



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out the Helping Hands printable.
Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

DO

1. Help your child cut out the Helping Hands printable and have them color it.
2. Trace your child's hand on multiple pieces of colored paper. (Number of handprints needed will vary depending on size of paper plate and hand size.)
 - Option: Include a color representative of their skin tone for your child to see their hand included on the wreath. Use a variety of other colors to show that everyone can help the way God says.
 - If you are using white paper, give your child crayons or markers to color the hands.
3. Help your child cut out their handprints.
4. Glue the printable to the center of the paper plate.
5. Glue the handprints around the paper plate.
6. Finish coloring and decorating the wreath.
