

MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE CRAFT | LESSON 6

ESTHER WINDOW CLINGS

Use this craft as a reminder that, because we are made in God's image, we can do what's right. Your child will remember that Esther stood up for what is right every time they look at their handmade window cling.

DIRECTIONS

PREP

 Print out the Esther printable. Option: Kids can create their own designs using the printable as a guide or things that remind them of the Bible story.

DO

- 1. Help your child mix some of the glue with food coloring. (Repeat for however many colors your child would like to use.)
- 2. Place the printable under the clear, plastic bag or inside a page protector.
- 3. Give your child paint brushes or Q-tips to make the picture of Esther and their own designs or shapes using a thick layer of the glue mixture on the clear, plastic bag or page protector.
- 4. Once the glue is dry, peel your designs off the plastic and stick to a window or mirror.
 - Tip: If your window cling does not stick, wet the back a little.
