



ICE BLOCK RESCUE

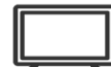
In this activity, your child will use various brushes and tools to help “rescue” their waterproof toys and figurines from a block of ice. This activity reminds them that they can help people like the Good Samaritan.



DIRECTIONS

1. Fill a glass or plastic container $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way with water.
2. Place several small, waterproof toys and figurines throughout the container.
3. Set the container in the freezer for several hours – until the water is frozen.
4. Remove the container from the freezer and place it outside or on a water-safe surface for your child.
5. Set your child up with a paintbrush, cup of warm water, salt, and toy tools.
6. Instruct them to use these items to melt or chip at the ice and “rescue” their toys.
7. Once their toys are safe, they can use a blanket or towel to help warm them up and take care of them!

SUPPLIES NEEDED



Glass or plastic container



Cup of warm water



Multiple small, waterproof toys and figurines



Paintbrush



Salt



Toy tools (optional)



Blanket or towel
