### **SERVE CHALLENGE**

Use the list of serve opportunities below to discuss with your child and encourage them to choose a few ways they can serve. You can even serve together as a family!

#### 1. Volunteer or Donate to your Local Food Pantry

Check out your local food pantry for opportunities to volunteer and/or donate food items! Gather up neighbors, friends, and family and serve together or organize a food drive to collect nonperishable items.
