CHRISTMAS FINGER PUPPETS

Use this craft to tell the story of the shepherds from the Christmas story in a fun way. Your child will make their own finger puppets and decorate three scenes from the Bible story to tell this part of Jesus' story!

DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out one copy of each printable.
Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

DO

1. Your child will color both printables.
2. Help your child cut out the finger puppet pieces.
3. Wrap the tabs around your child's finger and tape to secure. (Add an extra strip of paper if you need a longer wrap.)
4. Fold the scene printable and tape it in place.
5. Have fun playing with your child and telling the story about the shepherds' first Christmas. Use each scene background as a prompt for each part of the story.

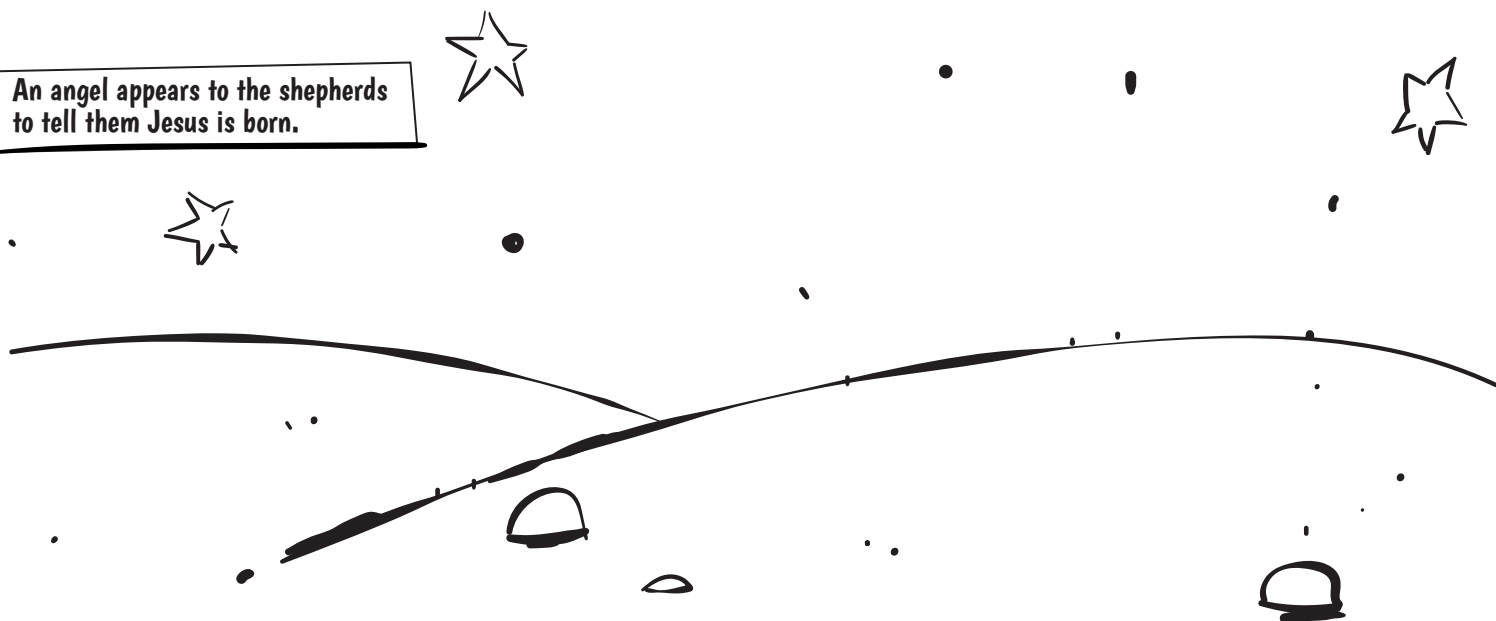

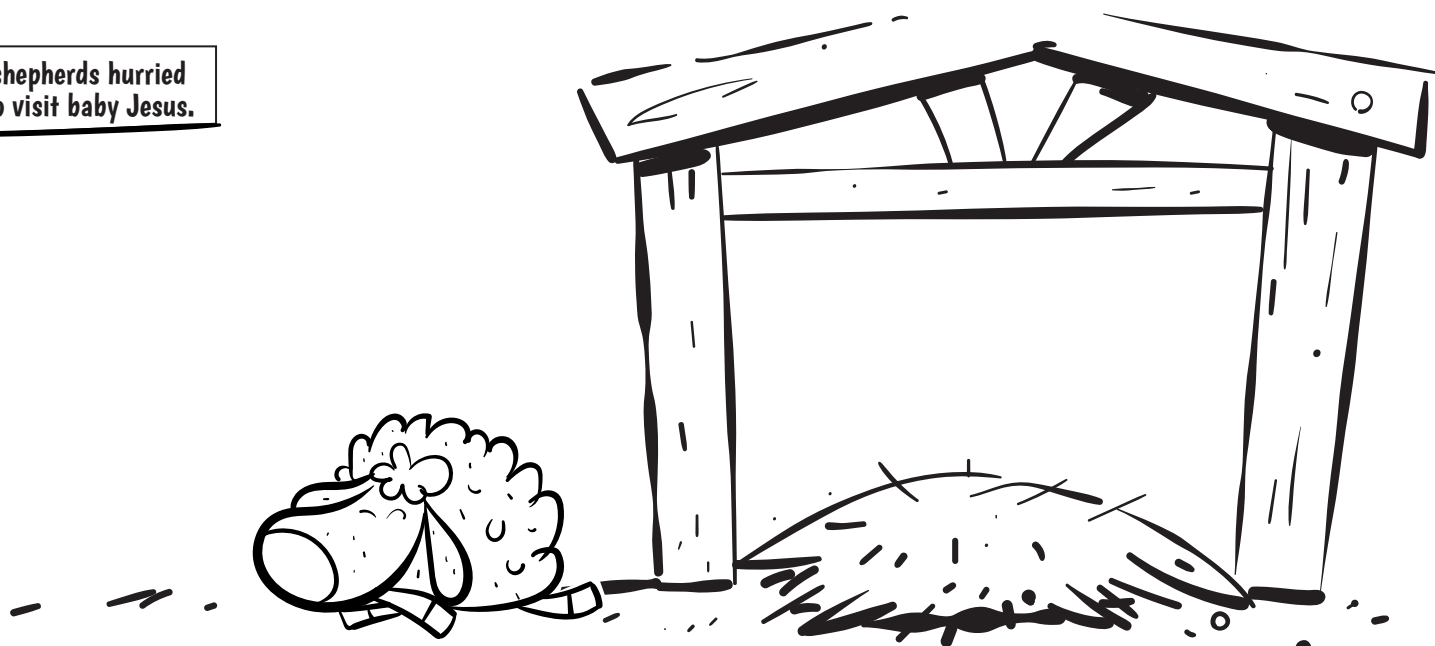
TALKING POINTS

- Who can you tell the story to?

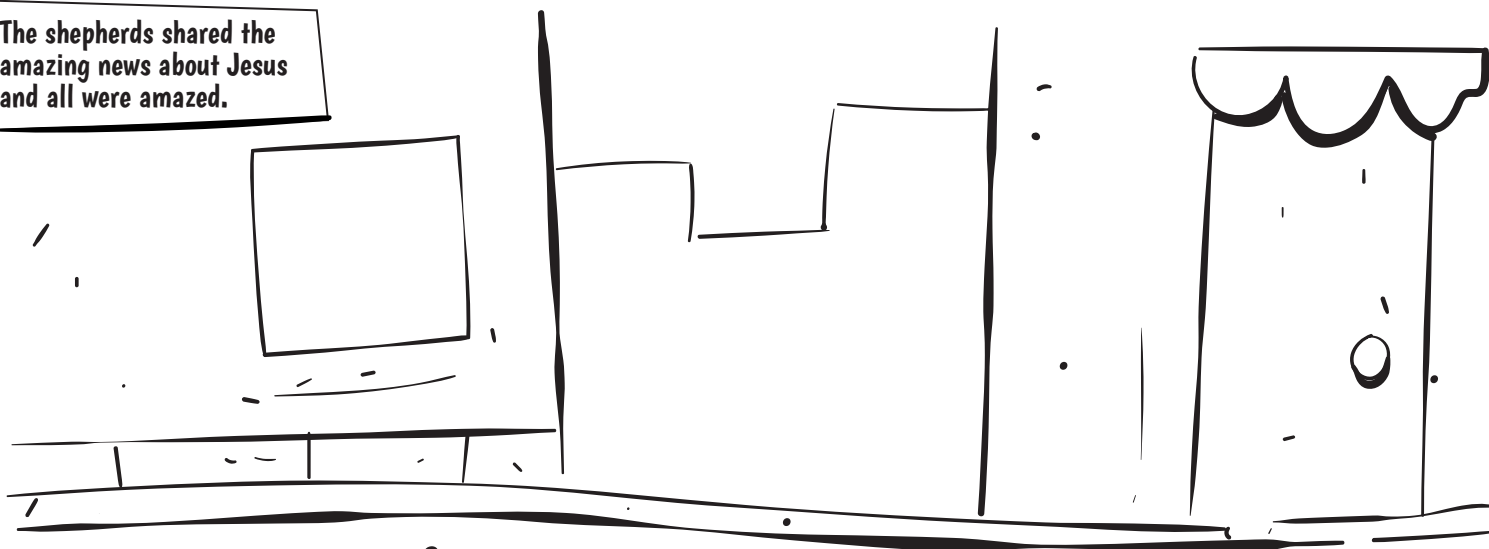
An angel appears to the shepherds

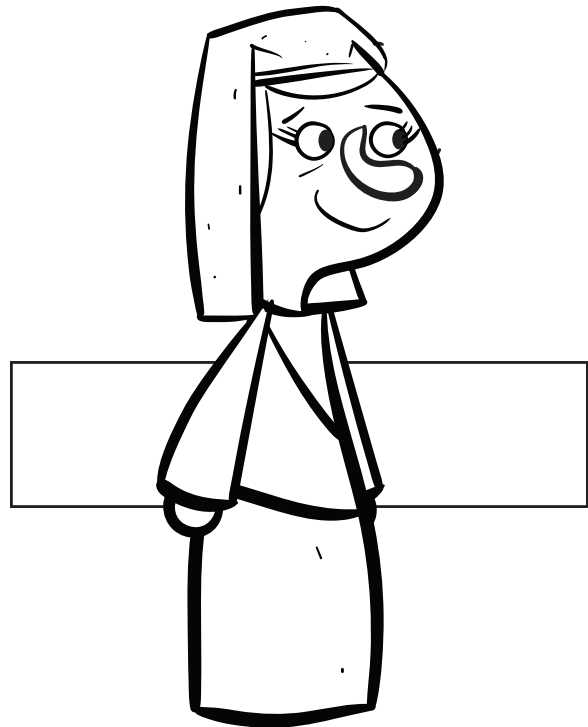
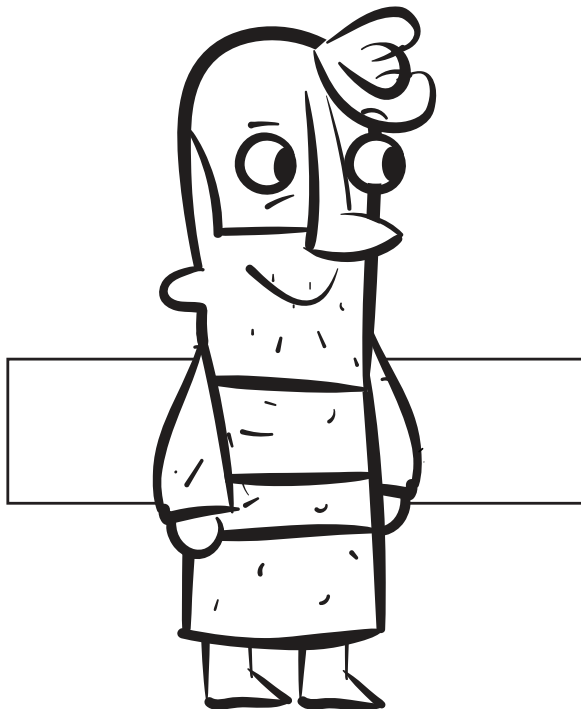
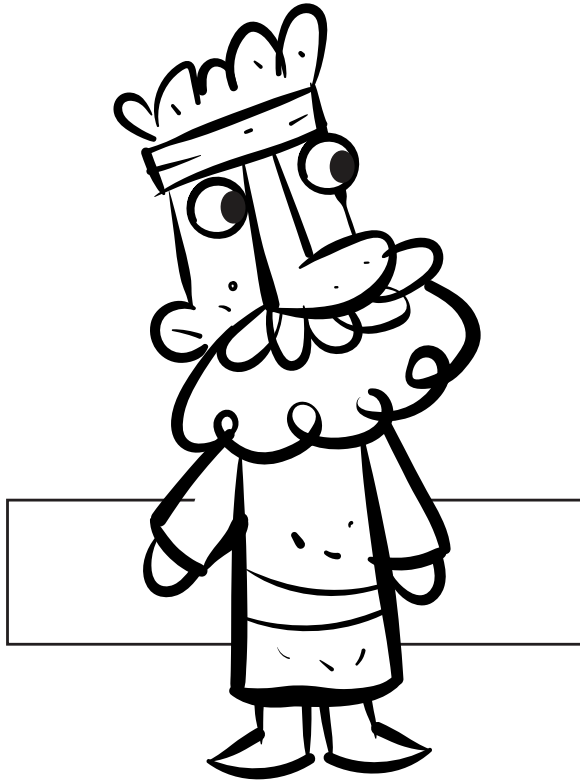
