



## GUESS WHAT?

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Supplies: Paper, pen/pencil, 4+ players (recommended but not required)

Directions:

1. Give each player a piece of paper and pen or pencil.
2. Begin by choosing from one of the following categories: movie, show, book, or song.
3. Everyone begins by *writing* down the name of one title in that category on their paper, and folding over a small portion of the paper to cover what they just wrote.
4. When everyone is done, pass the paper to the person to the right.
5. Peek under the folded tab to see what the person before you wrote, then fold it back down. In the space below, *draw* your own depiction of what the person wrote.
6. Fold the paper again to cover the drawing and repeat by passing it to the right again.
7. Only peek under the most recent fold at the picture (not the original title!) and guess what they *drew* by *writing* down the title of the book, movie, or whatever you think it is.
8. Repeat by going back and forth between *drawing* and *writing* your guess until the paper reaches its original owner.
9. Each person ends the game by unfolding their paper completely and sharing with the other players what their original title was and how it changed as the game went on.

## TALKING POINTS

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Get together and talk about how this game helps us think about this week's Bible story.

- That was so fun! It was so funny to see how the message spread throughout the course of the game. Sometimes it stayed the same and sometime it changed – a lot!
- How does this game remind you of our Bible story today where we learned about sharing about Jesus? Just like we spread a message in the game, one of our purposes on Earth is to spread the message of Jesus! But sometimes it doesn't always go perfectly, just like in the game.
- When we feel unprepared or like we can't share Jesus perfectly, he is always with us. He gives us the Holy Spirit and helps give us the words to say. And the Holy Spirit can help

prepare the other person to listen to what we have to say! So it doesn't matter if what we share is perfect, it only matters that what we share is true and honest.

- Who is someone you think you could share about Jesus with? How would you do that?
- How does it make you feel to talk to someone about Jesus? How can I help you be confident and share the message of Jesus?
