

Remembering Christmas

supplies

Bible, creative building supplies such as Legos or blocks, gingerbread cookies or graham crackers, costumes, etc., writing utensil, paper and tape

directions

- 1. Open up your Bible and read the Christmas story. Try the first two chapters from the books of Matthew or Luke to start, or use a children's Bible with your younger kids.
- 2. Decide together on a creative way to recreate the first Christmas by either building a scene from the Christmas story or acting one out!
- 3. Gather your supplies, assign tasks to each family member, and get to work!
- 4. Review the family discussion questions below and spend some time during this activity talking about the importance of Christmas together.

Additional supplies: Paper, pens, tape

- What is one of your favorite memories from Christmas this year?
- What is your favorite part of the Christmas story?
- Recreating the Christmas story like this helps us remember it. What is something you will always remember about the story of the first Christmas?
