MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE SELF PORTRAIT

Use this craft to remind your child that they are God's masterpiece. As they create their own self-portrait, they will see that they are beautifully made in God's image and loved by him.



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Give your child a paper plate.
- Tell them, "Just like God made Adam and Eve, God made you. He says you are very special to him and he loves you so much. There is no one like you, and that's the way God wanted it to be."
- 3. Have them draw a picture of themselves on the paper plate.
 - Option: Give your child a mirror so they can see themselves as they make their self-portrait.
- 4. Once they finish their self-portrait, talk with your child about some special things that you see in them. Write them on the paper plate.
